IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Children who are four (4) years of age on or before December 31, 2018, are eligible to attend.
- Registrations by telephone will not be accepted. Registration must be completed in person at the school. At that time, the child's birth certificate, provincial health card and completed school registration form are required to complete the registration process.
- The School Registration Form for 2018-2019 may be accessed in the Document Depot section of the Strait Regional School Board website at www.srsb.ca or at the school.
- It is not necessary for children to accompany parents/guardians to the school for registration.
- Families must live within the respective school's catchment area to be eligible to attend.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for transporting their children to and from the pre-primary program.
- Children may only attend the Program for one year.
- There is no fee for the Program.
- The Program will run from September 2018 to June 2019.
