**PHYSIOTHERAPY ASSISTANT:

The primary purpose of this position is to promote the health and physical well being of Residents by implementing customized programs for each Resident under the direction of the Physiotherapist and Occupational Therapist. Incumbents of the position are to work within their scope of practice and under the direction of the Policies and Procedures of Alderwood. The role includes working as part of a team with the goal to maintain or improve function and/or restore loss of mobility by preparing and applying modalities as directed by the OT/PT. The PA plays an active role in OHS by providing training for equipment, falls prevention and safe work practices such as lifting and transferring. The PA is responsible to maintain an up-to-date inventory of equipment and adaptive devices and to ensure that residents have access to the appropriate equipment which is well maintained.

REQUIREMENTS:

- At minimum, completion and certification of OT/PT Assistant or Rehab Assistant program or equivalent
- Demonstrates a clear understanding of rehabilitation principles and modalities in the provision of therapy as directed by the Physiotherapist and Occupational Therapist
- Capable to meet the physical demands of the position including walking; stooping; standing for prolonged periods of time; reaching, lifting and transferring residents/equipment
- Good attendance record
- Protect own health and safety and the health and safety of others by adopting safe work practices, reporting unsafe conditions immediately, and attending relevant in-services and meetings as directed
- Follows all guidelines for employees and employers as legislated under the Nova Scotia Occupational Health and Safety Act
