Details pertaining to the use of swimming pools are as follows:

- Pool would be required daily for a 3-hour period (either 9:00 am – 12:00 pm or 1:00 – 4:00 pm) and for 3 consecutive weeks (either July 2 – 19 or July 22-August 9).
- Pool must be able to accommodate up to 20 swimmers of various ages comfortably,
- Pool must have a shallow end that is a maximum of 4 feet.
- Location must have sufficient parking for parents/guardians of participants.
- Location must have cellular reception in case of emergencies.

\*\*\* Please note, there will be NO access to the resident's home during swimming lessons. The Municipality will provide portable toilets on location.
